Final Exam Exemption Rules

Seniors may exempt county semester exams if they meet the following criteria:

- Earn at least three quality points (a C average), with a passing grade in each quarter
- No debts
- No more than five absences in the class
- No Out-of-School Suspension/EPIC
- Must have attended all assigned discipline
 - Please note: A college visit will only be coded as "school business" if the student is participating in a MANDATORY/REQUIRED activity such as an audition or scholarship interview. Documentation must be provided in advance of missing school for this reason. Seniors cannot appeal to exempt their exams because of absences, only discipline. This is a district policy. If a student has an extreme extenuating circumstance, that should go to Mr. Stephenson.

- Each student will receive 10 tickets for friends and family to attend graduation at the completion of rehearsal.
