Program Overview: Begin an exciting career in transportation construction with FREE job training at Gateway Community & Technical College. This program is offered in partnership with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and the University of Kentucky Transportation Technology Transfer Center.

- Opportunity for sponsorship in GCTC Commercial Driver’s License (CDL) for select individuals.
- Be ready for Road Construction job opportunities.

Following completion of the training, you will have the opportunity to apply as a full time employee to work on the Brent Spence Bridge project. Hiring will take place in the 2nd quarter of 2026. To apply for the prevailing wage job, you must be 18 years of age. Individuals hired to work this project will earn a prevailing wage in the range of \$18-30 per hour.
